

Camping Checklist (winter)

Boy Scout Handbook

Shelter and Bedding

- sleeping bag (rated to 0 degrees F if sleeping outdoors)
- Sleeping bag liner (for less than the warmest bags)
- warm blanket
- sleeping pad (ground insulation critical)
- pillowcase (stuff with clothes for a pillow)

Cooking and Dining

- mess kit; or drinking cup (for hot or cold liquids) and reusable/washable plate
- spoon, knife, fork
- water bottle (refillable, filled)

Clothes

- 2 long sleeve t-shirts
- underwear
- Long underwear, top and bottom, polypropylene
- 2 pairs jeans/pants
- sweatpants
- warm socks (3 pairs)
- waterproof boots or hiking shoes (2 pairs)
- sweater / sweat shirt / fleece
- winter parka
- Snow pants or bibs
- Hat to cover ears or face mask
- 2 pair waterproof gloves
- laundry bag or plastic bag for dirty clothes

Personal Hygiene

- tooth brush, tooth paste
- towel and washcloth
- soap
- comb/brush
- toilet paper
- personal medication (please let the scoutmaster know if you have any)

Miscellaneous Items

- camera (optional)
- cards, games (electronic games not allowed)
- compass (optional)
- duct tape (optional)
- flashlight/extra batteries
- pocket knife (optional)
- First aid kit
- pen and paper
- rope/clothesline
- healthy snack (trail mix)
- handwarmers
